The Favoured team is in **BOLD** and underlined. Please check that you understand which team is favoured. Only one sheet per person is permitted. Deadline is Friday Jan. 16 at 9:00 PM.

Please make the following three choices for each game and **CIRCLE** the team you select in the appropriate box next to the respective game:

- 1) the outright winner of the game;
- 2) the team that “covers” or beats the published point spread; and
- 3) **CIRCLE** “over” or “under” in the appropriate box to select your choice regarding the published point total for each game.

Each correct selection is worth 1 point. There is a maximum total of 12 points if all the picks made are correct. The winner is the entry with the most correct picks selected. The tiebreaker is the total points of the last game on Sunday (LA Rams at Chicago). If there are multiple entries with the same number of correct picks, then the winner is the entry with the closest tiebreaker point total to the actual point total of the last game on Sunday without going over the actual point total. If there is a tie in the Total Points, then those entries will be co-winners.

n.b. The same tiebreaker procedure as used during the regular season.
